RECESSIONAL SONG:

Note: The Ceremony is over, and it is time to march back down the aisle. The Recessional usually occurs in the reverse order of the Processional, but with the Groomsmen and Junior Groomsmen usually accompanying the Bridesmaids and Junior Bridesmaids.

After the unity ceremony, the Bride and Groom present a single rose each to the Mother of the Bride and Mother of the Groom, along with a kiss and a hug, as a sign of their love for them. Grandparents

and/or other family members may also be included. This is usually a surprise for the recipients.
